More than one hundred countries across the world take part in World Book Day each year.

On World Book Day, fourteen million book tokens, worth £1 each, are handed out to children across the country. The token can be exchanged, at participating bookshops, for one of ten exciting books. Each book has been selected carefully for World Book Day, but if none of the titles appeal to you, then simply use your token to get a £1 discount off any book you like. Then have fun losing yourself in a whole new adventure!

How are you going to enjoy World Book Day this year? Here are a few ideas for you to try:

- Dress up as your favourite character.
- Illustrate a front cover.
- Write the blurb for a back cover.
- Write a review of your favourite book.
- Pretend you are interviewing your favourite illustrator.
- Invite an author into school.
- Rewrite the ending of a story.
- Illustrate and describe a character.
- Illustrate and describe a setting.
- Sit in a circle and take turns in adding bits to a story. Where will your adventure take you?

As well as leading you into unexplored, imaginative new worlds, books are an important resource; helping to educate people around the world.
