2. Can you find three facts in the second paragraph about Osiris's physical appearance?
3. In the final paragraph, it says, "You may leave me now. Thank you for your attentions," he said firmly.' What can you work out about Osiris by reading this sentence?

4. What reason does Osiris give for wanting a drink of water? (paragraph 2)

5. Why do the servants adore Osiris? (paragraph 2)
  
6. What word in the second paragraph tells you that other rooms in the palace are extravagantly decorated and luxurious?
  
7. What two adverbs are used to describe the way that Osiris speaks in the second paragraph?
  
8. How did Osiris know that he was doing a good job as a pharaoh? (paragraph 3)
